Location

B-29 Bomber Wreck, Lake Mead, Nevada.

Conditions

20-40 foot horizontal visibility, 145 ft fresh water, 1100' mean sea level elevation, water temp 50° F.

Comments

The B-29 Superfortress bomber crashed into Lake Mead in 1948, after testing a prototype missile guidance system. The huge bomber hit the water at an airspeed of 230 mph. The pilot managed to wrestle the bomber back into the air and then the crew ditched.

Of the four engines, only the outboard, port engine remains intact. Tail section cracked at mid fuselage. The pilot controls appear untouched. Great Dive!
